Brief Information of Ponda Education Society

The Ponda Education Society was established in the year 1984 by prominent educationists and social workers of Ponda to benefit the students of Ponda Taluka and surrounding areas who had to travel long distances to obtain higher education. The vision of the Society was to work towards social upliftment with special emphasis on higher education for local students and those from the neighbouring areas. The Society is registered under the Society's Registration Act-1860 bearing the No. 34/GOA/84 on 26th March 1984 for literary, scientific and charitable purpose.

Since the inception, the college to its record has tremendous achievements both at the National and University level. Students have been awarded 17 gold medals at B. Pharm. and M. Pharm. examination of Goa University till date. The college was ranked in the band of 76-100 by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India in 2017, 2018 and 2019. The B.Pharm Programme is accredited by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) for a period of three years (2023-2026).

4. Infrastructure

PES's Rajaram and Tarabai Bandekar College of Pharmacy is situated in a serene and eco-friendly environment surrounded by lush greenery. The institution is equipped with modern infrastructure that supports academic excellence, research, and holistic student development. The campus houses a well-organized Administrative Office, spacious and well-equipped Laboratories, Tutorial rooms, smart Classrooms with audio-visual facilities, a Computer Laboratory, a Central Instrumentation Facility, a Pilot Plant, a CCSEA-approved Animal House, a Computer-Aided Drug Design Laboratory, a Training and Placement Cell, a well-stocked Library, an Auditorium, and a Pharmacy Museum. The institution maintains adequate floor area in accordance with statutory requirements. The Central Instrumentation Facility is equipped with sophisticated instruments such as HPLC, FTIR, UV-Visible Spectrophotometer, and Spectrofluorimeter. The Pilot Plant is furnished with advanced pharmaceutical manufacturing equipment, including a tablet compression machine, coating machine, bottle sealing machine, double-cone blender, Martin Christ Lyophilizer, UV-Visible Spectrophotometer, IKA Rotary Evaporator, and Cold Centrifuge. The CCSEA approved Animal House facilitates research activities involving animal studies.

The college library is a rich repository of knowledge, housing 9,564 books, including 2,244 reference books. It subscribes to 14 national journals, 4 international journals, and provides access to 916 e-journals. Additional resources include plagiarism detection software, and the Infotrac Pharmacy e-journal package through DELNET. Dedicated internet facilities are available for both students and staff. The Placement and Training Cell actively organizes campus recruitment drives and career development activities with leading pharmaceutical industries.

The college also promotes the overall development of students through various co-curricular, extracurricular, and social outreach activities. These include health awareness programmes, blood donation camps, street plays, awareness rallies, and community engagement initiatives. Students are encouraged to actively participate in sports, cultural events, and leadership activities, fostering their all-round growth and professional development.

1. Eligibility

A candidate desirous of joining the M. Pharm. programme at P.E.S's Rajaram and Tarabai Bandekar College of Pharmacy should:

A) be a Citizen of India.

B) * i) Successfully have passed the B. Pharm Degree Examination of any Institution/ University in India approved by Pharmacy Council of India and has scored not less than 55% of the maximum marks (aggregate of 4 years of B.Pharm.) and have successfully cleared Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT). However, if GPAT qualified candidates are not available, then the vacant seats shall be filled by admitting candidates without GPAT, based on the aggregate marks obtained at B. Pharm. (CGPA) and/or Merit.

ii) For SC/ST candidates, the prescribed percentage of marks will be 50% of the maximum marks (aggregate of 4 years of B.Pharm.)

iii) Every student, selected for admission to post graduate pharmacy program should have obtained registration with the State Pharmacy Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of his/her admission failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.

The following conversion formula for conversion of grade to percentage shall be followed as per Ordinance OA-16 for Candidates of Goa University.

Percentage = (CGPA - 0.75) X 10

Note:

- I) It is mandatory to submit a migration certificate obtained from the respective University where the candidate has passed his/her qualifying degree (B.Pharm.)
- II) When GPAT qualified candidates (valid GPAT Score) are not available, admission shall be given to Non-GPAT candidates who are domiciled in Goa. Thereafter, if seats still remain vacant then admission shall be given to Non-GPAT candidates of other non-Goa University subject to fulfillment of applicable admission regulations.

2. Scholarships/Stipends

GPAT 2026 qualified candidates admitted to the programme shall be eligible for a monthly stipend of Rs. 12,400/- from the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi.*

Candidates admitted to this programme, if eligible, can avail Scholarships as per notifications by Govt. of Goa / Govt. of India.

* Subject to approval from concerned authorities.

6. Terms & Conditions

- I) The academic session is divided into four semesters (six months duration each) or as directed by the PCI/Goa University for M. Pharm. course.
- II) A candidate shall be required to attend atleast 75% of the number of lectures and practicals for each course in each semester and then, subject to other conditions being fulfilled shall be eligible to appear at either the College or Goa University Examination.
- III) A dissertation shall be submitted by the students on their project work at the end of the fourth semester to be evaluated by the examiners appointed by the Goa University.

7. Rules of Admission

1. The Application form for the admission is included in the prospectus. The applicant should submit the application form duly filled in mentioning his/her category such as SC, ST, OBC, General etc. along with self attested photocopies of the relevant certificates & testimonials at the admission centre in P.E.S's Rajaram & Tarabai Bandekar College of Pharmacy, Farmagudi, Ponda, Goa and obtain the acknowledgment card with registration number.
2. Admission will be given to deserving candidates only, mere submission of Application form does not confer any right/claim for admission to M. Pharm. programme.
3. The Application form should be filled in by the applicant in his/her own handwriting and duly signed by him/her.
4. Every eligible candidate seeking admission to M. Pharm. programme shall remain present in person at the admission round along with the acknowledgment card, original

documents specified under the title of certificates and testimonials along with the fees of 1st semester commencing from 5th August 2026. The 2nd term fee has to be given in the beginning of the second term i.e. last week of January 2027. The fees would be as per the directions of DTE, Govt. of Goa. The candidates are admitted provisionally till they satisfy the requirements of certificates mentioned in the prospectus. The original of all testimonials will be retained in the college.

5. When the candidate is admitted to M. Pharm. programme, he/she shall be required to submit the original College Leaving Certificate or Transfer Certificate as the case may be, within 7 days from the date of admission or as per time allotted by admission committee, failing to do so, the admission shall be cancelled.
6. All the applicants selected for admission shall be required to produce the medical fitness certificate from authorized registered medical practitioner.
7. The admitted candidates wishing to apply for scholarships and loan facility are required to submit certificates of SC, ST, OBC, and any other category and/or income certificate accordingly as per the rules of the loan/scholarship issuing authorities.
8. The decision of the Admission Committee & Management of P. E. S. shall be final in interpreting the rule of admission to M. Pharm. programme in this college.

8. Certificates and Testimonials

Self-attested photocopies of relevant certificates and testimonials should be attached to the application form and the same shall be tick marked in the checklist, on the form.

1. Two recent passport size photographs taken not later than 3 months prior to the date of application one of which is required to affix to the application form in the space provided & the other one to be fixed on Acknowledgment card.
2. Copy of statement of marks of all four years of B. Pharm
3. GPAT 2026 score card (if qualified).
4. Copy of certificate of date of Birth from Competent Authority.
5. Copy of College leaving certificate signed by the Principal of the Institute.
6. Residence Certificate.
7. Candidates from outside Goa University need to submit an eligibility certificate from Registrar, Goa University at the time of admission and migration certificate from the respective Universities within 30 days from the date of admission.

Note: If admission is confirmed, originals of the above certificates have to be submitted in the office

Mode of payment of fees

All fees for first semester should be paid through Demand Draft / Cheque in favour of the authority mentioned below:

Candidate must write his/her name on backside of the Demand Draft while submitting the same to this institution.

Fees of First semester should be paid in the beginning of Semester by Demand Draft / Cash / Bank Challan drawn in at **PES's Rajaram and Tarabai Bandekar College of Pharmacy**.

Fees of second semester should be paid in the beginning of 2nd Semester.

10. Cancellation of Admission & Refund of fees

Cancellation of Admission by Admission Authority or Head of the Institute:

1. An Applicant who has paid the fees at the college but has failed to report to the college within 3 working days of the grant of admission, shall forfeit the claim for admission.
2. If any information / Certificate submitted by the applicant in connection with his/her admission is found to be incorrect later on at any time, then his/her admission shall be cancelled and the entire fees shall be forfeited.

11. Student Discipline

1. Students are required to behave themselves in a disciplined manner inside and outside the campus of the College. The students of this College shall maintain a minimum attendance of 75% in each subject in theory as well as in practical as per university circular no. 1/107/12- ACAD-1 /2012/5276, before commencement of theory/practical internal examination during the academic year, failing which the Head of the Institution will not allow the candidate to appear for internal examination and he shall be constrained not to submit his/her examination form to the University.
2. Students organizing anti-institution activities, mass bunking, destroying or impairing the utility of any property of the Institute are liable for disciplinary action, including dismissal. The decisions and the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India shall be applied to all cases involving 'ragging'.
3. Ragging, Smoking, taking intoxicating drinks and drugs are strictly prohibited. Students indulging in these undesirable habits will be severely dealt with in accordance with the law of the land. All students are required to comply with these. If any student is found ragging he/she may be debarred from the College accordingly.
4. Students are required to follow the dress code decided by the College.
5. In case of any student feeling unwell/indisposed, at the Institute, he/she is required to report to the staff concerned and/or the Principal and follow the instructions received and not to act unilaterally.
6. Attendance in the Internal tests is necessary.
7. Participation in the activities of other Institutions shall only be with the prior permission of the Head of the Institute.
8. Parents/Guardians are earnestly requested to meet the Principal and the staff frequently to get information about the academic progress and other activities of their wards.
9. Decision of the Principal shall be final in all matters of discipline, dress code and conduct.
10. To curb the menace of ragging, all the students and parents are hereby required to fill in a self certified affidavit online and give a copy of the same to the office.
